
Regional Malaria Trends Threshold Vs. Current cases, 2023 (wk 1-24)




Malaria trend in week 24,2023

- Malaria case shows increment by 13% in this week Compared with wk 23
- A total of 13,205 suspected cases were tested either RDT or microscope
 - 2,566 cases were positive for malaria with test positivity rate of 19%.
 - 1452(57%) were PF and 1,075(42%) were PV and 39(2%) were mixed
 - Out of reported 11(0.5%) cases were reported from in patient



1. Bona zuria _ Awaye keraro-Suke kebele

- Sidama RHB vise head, RHB staffs and SiPHI team deployed
- Woreda leaders deployed integrating with WoHO&HF
- Community conversation conducted at SUKE kebele & at 9 kebele led by woreda leaders ,WoHO & Kararo HF, at all cholera hot spot kebele
- Status of hygiene & sanitation (water sourced, Communal & private latrine visited by deployed team
- Deployed team visited Awaye keraro CTC
- 2 cholera suspected case (1 RDT+ve, & communication made with Bona Hospital staffs, hence stool sample sent for culture
- Shifting patients to temporal admission site
- All response team activated & response activities switched with WoHO

- ✓ Discussion made with head & staffs of Bensa WoHO staffs
- ✓ WoHO & Oda HC staffs deployed to Guddisa Gote for investigation.
- ✓ Contact tracing & Disinfection made by deployed team
- ✓ Over 10,000 water treatment chemical distributed
- ✓ Direction put for initiation of zero report including private clinics, issuances of alert letter for private clinic,

3. Wondo genet woreda_ Wosha Soyama -

 Following attending cholera confirmed case from Mender-1 the following activities conducted

Team deployed from : EPHI(2),SRHB Regulatory (3)+SiPHI (3)+ W/G WoHO (4) + Wosha HC(4)

- ✓ CTC established
- ✓ Necessary cholera treatment supplied
- ✓ Investigation of leakage of wabishebele latrine with river integrating with Sidama Region Regulatory Directorate
- ✓ Environmental sampling (water sample taken from 7 sources)
- ✓ After confirming the leakage of toilet with river, we communicate with wabishebele staffs to avail alternative toilet
- ✓ Direction put for initiation of zero report including private clinics, issuances of alert letter for private clinic,

- Community engagement seen on Cholera prevention&Control held by Kebele chairman at Wosha_Soyama kebele with kebele leaders,WoHO &Wosha HC staff,HEW,HDA,and stalkholders
- Focused on private and communal latrine availability and use
- Access of hand washing facility after latrine use
- Other any risk factors w/c provoke cholera outbreak at large in their kebele(Car washing area, breakage of drinking water pipe)
